The Granada Hills North Neighborhood Council, on advice of our D.O.N.E. Neighborhood Council Project Advocate and the City Attorney's Office, respectfully requests that the Porter Ranch Neighborhood Council coordinate with the GHNNC to amend the definition of our shared boundary (Aliso Canyon) in our respective bylaws.

Because D.O.N.E. cannot find a Determination Letter on record that definitively specifies our Aliso Canyon boundary line, and the approved D.O.N.E. maps of our boundaries conflict with each other (sometimes overlapping, and sometimes leaving small areas unrepresented), the GHNNC has been asked to coordinate with the PRNC to define this boundary more accurately.

Currently, the PRNC's Bylaws define your boundaries as, *"The 118 Freeway to the south, the east side of Browns Canyon Road from the City Line to the gate at the south of Brown's Canyon, then in a straight line to the 118 Freeway on the west, the City line to the north and northwest, and Aliso Canyon to the east."*

The GHNNC would like to offer the following three revisions for the PRNC Board to consider:

**PROPOSAL #1:** "The 118 Freeway to the south, the east side of Browns Canyon Road from the City Line to the gate at the south of Brown's Canyon, then in a straight line to the 118 Freeway on the west, the City line to the north and northwest, and then along the western edge of Aliso Canyon to the east."

**PROPOSAL #2:** "The 118 Freeway to the south, the east side of Browns Canyon Road from the City Line to the gate at the south of Brown's Canyon, then in a straight line to the 118 Freeway on the west, the City line to the north and northwest, and Aliso Canyon to the east (with the understanding that Aliso Canyon Park is designated for public use and, as such, is a shared boundary with the Granada Hills North Neighborhood Council under Article III, Section 2 of The City of Los Angeles' Plan for a Citywide System of Neighborhood Councils)."

**PROPOSAL #3:** "The 118 Freeway to the south, the east side of Browns Canyon Road from the City Line to the gate at the south of Brown's Canyon, then in a straight line to the 118 Freeway on the west, the City line to the north and northwest, and then along the eastern edge of Aliso Canyon to the east."
