1. Call to Order. Introductions.

2. New Business:

Sphere of Influence: Negative Declartion-841-04-PL: ENV-2004-7108. The area that the Sphere of Influence the City of Los Angeles is seeking to amend is located in North Los Angeles County, outside the existing limits of the City of Los Angeles. The general boundaries of the sphere are west to east, unincorporated areas near Dayton Canyon northward along the Ventura County line to the ridgeline of the Santa Susana Mountains, turning eastwardly along the ridge line of the Santa Susana Mountains to the limits of the City of Santa Clarita at the Sierra Highway, and following the limits to the south and then east and continuing to follow the ridge line eastward to and along the boundary of the Angeles National Forest, and turning southward to a terminus south of Little Tujunga Road. The project is a plan for modification to the adopted sphere of Council Districts 2, 7 and 12. The proposed area covers 19,242 acres or approximately 30 miles.

One of the purposes of this meeting is to discuss the Sphere of Influence amendment and how this may impact the stakeholders we represent, in preparation for submittal of questions and comments jointly and/or as individual neighborhood councils.

The City Planning Department has been invited to talk on this item.

Audit by City Controller Laura Chick: The City Controller has requested that neighborhood councils offer questions and comments in preparation for audits of the Department of Building and Safety, Planning and Recreation and Parks.

As Planning and Land Use Committees we are familiar with these departments and we should give our input. We can give these questions and or comments jointly and/or as individual neighborhood councils.
