- C. Discussion and possible motion on safety concerns with the proposed senior care facility located on the N/W corner of Rinaldi and Shoshone.

The proponent gave us an overview and answered some questions and/or agreed to further review safety issues raised by the Committee regarding service deliveries, hours of operation, ingress and egress, traffic on Shoshone, the materials used on the exterior design of a structure in a high fire hazard area, and also to review the structural condition of any ranch house for possible relocation. The Committee agreed that it will wait for more information before making any comments.

- D. Update on more traffic enforcement on Balboa between Balboa Road to Rinaldi.

LAPD VTD has increased its presence and has been working very hard on reducing speeding on Balboa

- E. Update on progress of “No Left Turn” and “No Right Turn” signs on Balboa.

Nothing new to report at this time, however, the Committee is considering going higher up the chain, in order to elicit action on the part of the City to correct and amend any installed signage that did not comport with the GHNNC’s original request.

- F. Update on installing a “No Left Turn” sign on southbound Blucher at Rinaldi.

Bill Cotter has been working with VTD and they have had many instances of “Intersection Takeovers” with people doing different exhibitions of speed.
